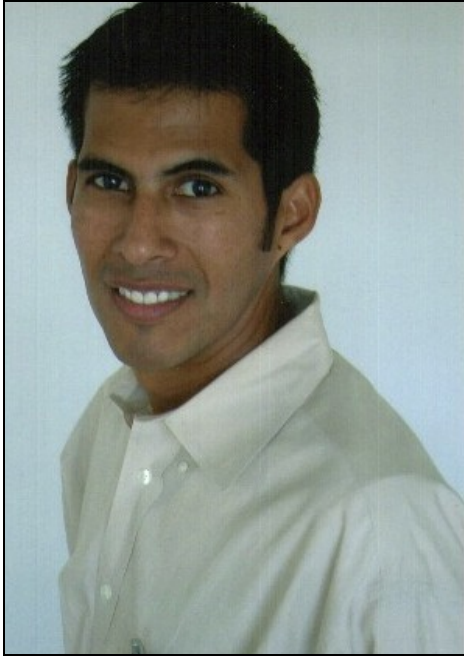


GABRIEL EGUSQUIZA

Gabriel from 13 years old, was part of the missions of the spirituality of the missionary combonianos in the city of Lima, taking provisions and instruction to the needy areas. Then between the 14 and 15 years, he was part of the missions of "Volunteers Papal Mission" O.M.P. for the Dioceses of Lima, carrying out works of charity, taking provisions and recreation activities to different institutions like "The House of the Mother from Calcutta", hospices for old men, Orphanages, Hospitals and others.

Between the ages of 16 and 18, he entered into the area of Latin American folklore music in different festivals in surrounding cities of Lima, such as the "Festival Taky", "Latin American Festival CICLA" and "Breezes of the Titicaca." In the 80's, Gabriel founded the Rock-Folk-fusion group "DIARIO", today called IAO ([IAO](http://www.iao.org)). They were able to incorporate rhythms of the Latin American folklore with other rhythms, and were awarded in several festivals among them "The Chapla Rock" "Festival of Rock Non Professional" "The Festival for the Peace". They also played the main theme music for the International movie "The Temptation Apple."

In the year of 1990, Gabriel finished his technical professional career in Clinical Laboratory. At the Superior School of Health Sergio Bernales. From the years 1990 at 1994, he worked as professor of Biological Sciences and Consultant in the Vocational Pastoral department of the Franciscan School "Our Lady of Hope" in the district of Salamanca. There, he obtained Diplomas of Honor for the best Professor in the first two years. In that time, he participated in different areas of pedagogic formation such as: Pedagogic and Administrative upgrade, Doctrinal Technician of the Consortium of Centers Educational Catholics of the Peru, Course of Catholic Doctrine of the Ability of Sciences and Humanities of the University of Piura, Ministry of Education and School of Parents ECCA and (F.I.E.P.) an organization that collaborates with the UNESCO, the UN and the UNICEF, National Convention of Centers Educational Catholics of the Peru, Departmental Office of Education Catholic Archbishopric of Lima Education in Values and Educational Methodology. In 1995, he took courses in the technical professional career of physical Rehabilitation and Physiotherapy.

Gabriel arrived in the United States in 1996 and worked for 5 years in "The University of South Western Medical Center at Dallas", in the department of Investigation of Cardiology, developing several projects for the Hispanic population.
